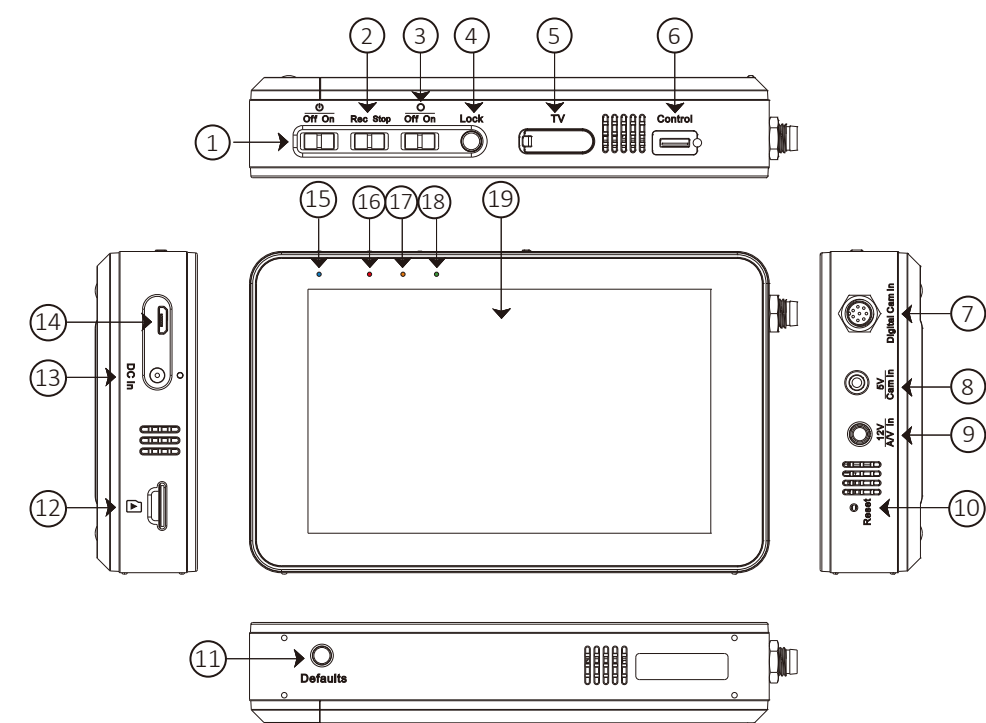


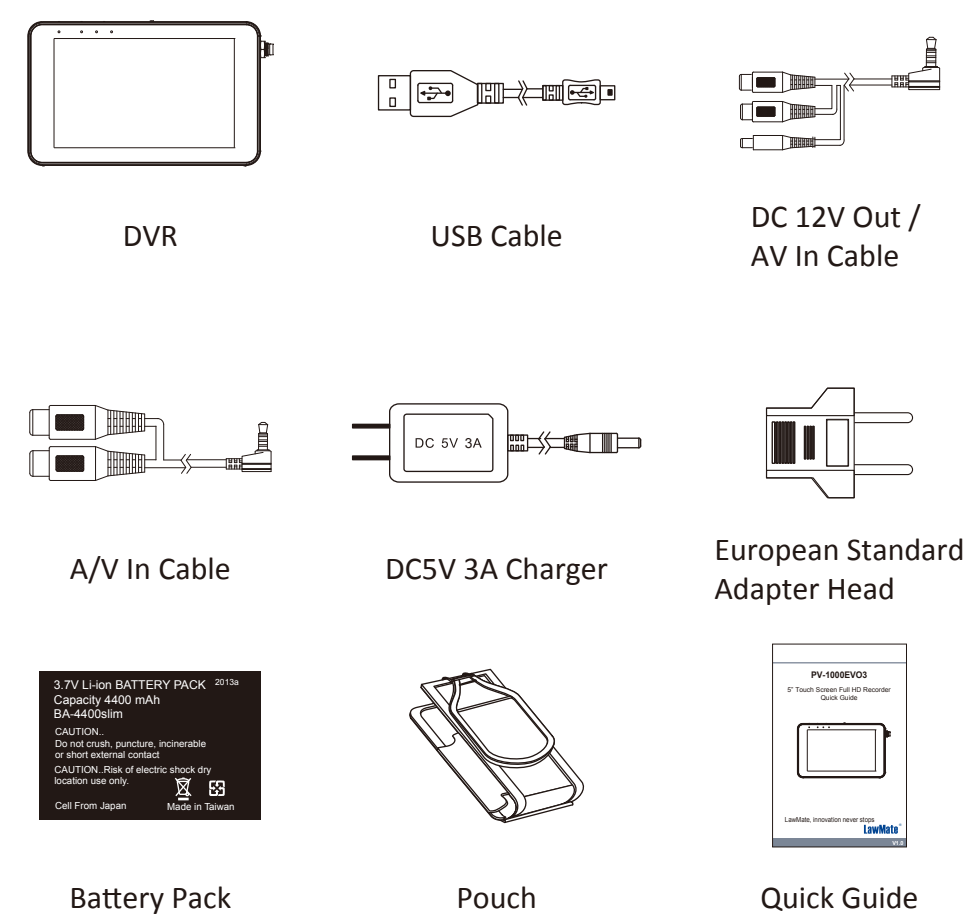

### 2. Package Content



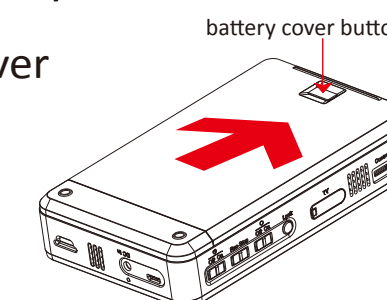
- ※ Note: Only use the supplied AC/DC charger to charge the DVR.

### 3. Install and Charge the Battery

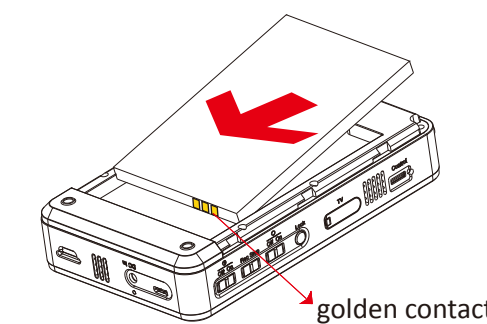
#### 3.1. Remove the battery cover

Press the battery cover button and slide the rear cover at the direction of the red pointing-arrow.



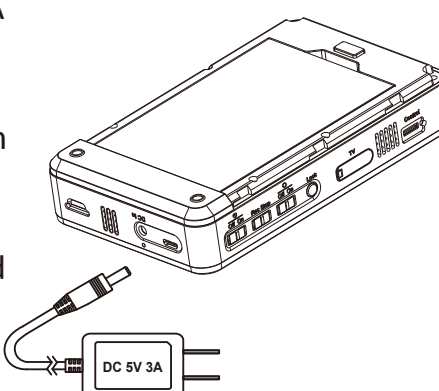
#### 3.2. Insert the battery

Align the golden contacts of the supplied battery with corresponding connectors on the device, then slide in the battery until it fits into place.



#### 3.3. Charging the battery

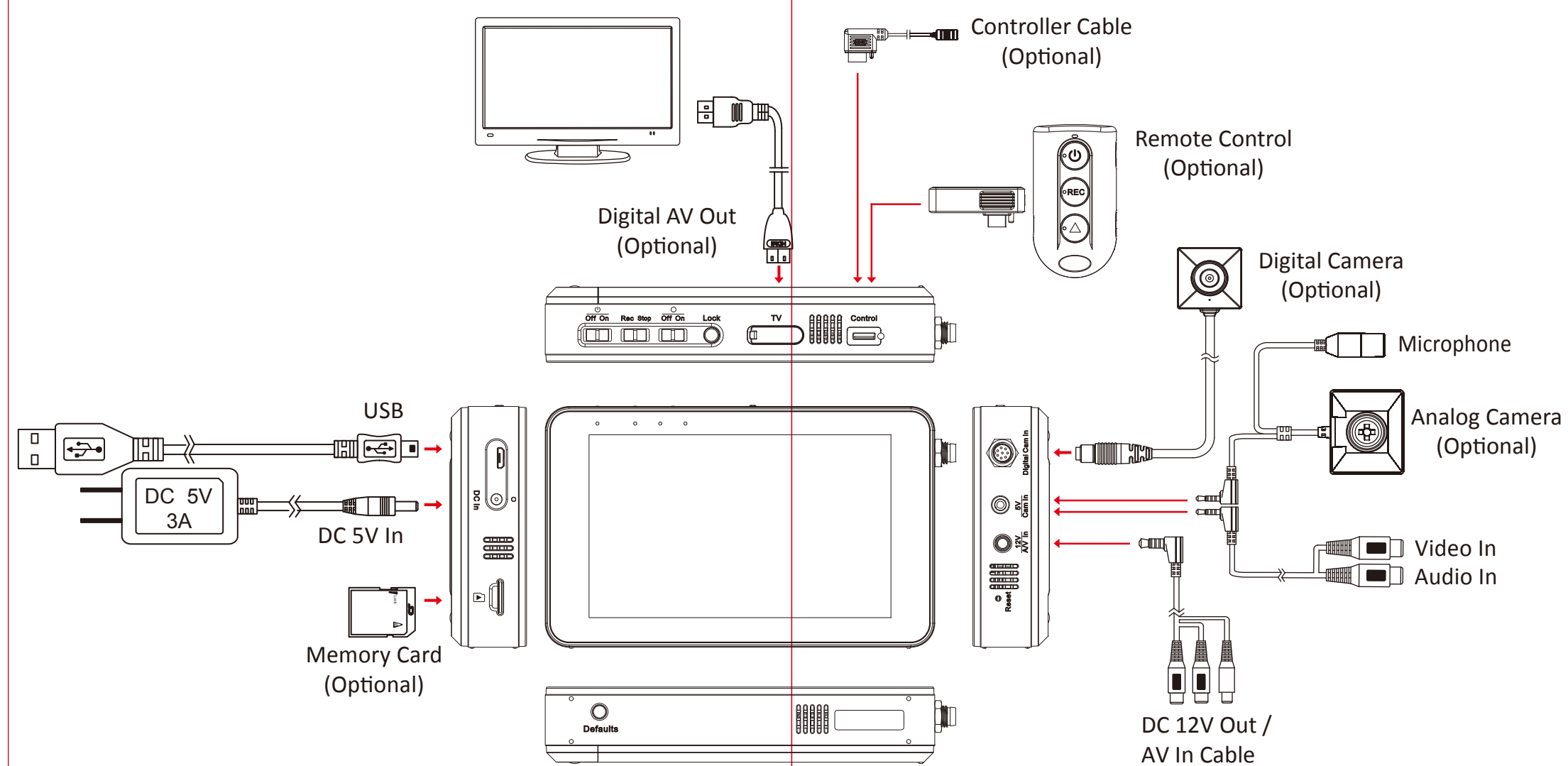
Plug the supplied DC 5V 3A charger to an AC wall outlet, then connect the other end of the power cord to the DC IN socket on the side of PV-1000EVO3. The red LED indicator will illuminate on when the battery is charging. The red LED will turn off when battery is fully charged.



Note: Always power on and off the DVR once after installing a new battery, failing to do so might result in charging failure.
